Dear runners, we're counting on you to return the smile! A small thank you, a kind glance in passing... It costs nothing, and it makes all the difference.



2. PACER

Pacers, or pacemakers, play a crucial role in a marathon by helping runners to maintain a steady pace and manage their energy. They act as visual and motivational cues to help runners reach specific time targets or finish the race without overworking themselves.



How do I get to the start of the Baloise Namur Marathon?

OPTION 1: I've chosen the shuttle bus

The TEC shuttles for your departure will be in front of Namur Expo, Avenue Sergent Vrithoff 2. The choice of shuttle is indicated by a pictogram on your race number. There are two shuttle times: **Tortue** at 7.15am and **Lièvre** at 8.05am.

OPTION 2: I don't take the shuttle bus

See the mobility point

─ Instructions

There is a detachable tab on your race number. It must be attached to your bag before being placed in the lorry that will take your bag to the finish. The maximum bag size is 30 litres. Only bags will be accepted at the drop-off point (no clothes, no suitcases).

If you are thinking of taking a piece of clothing to keep warm, you can drop it off at an ASBL TERRE container. The clothes will then be recycled. You can pick up your bag in the runners' area after the finish. It will be stored in the file corresponding to your race number.

Lockers

The men's and women's changing rooms with showers are located at the Tabora sports centre Tabora sports centre, 500m from Namur Expo (follow the arrows from Namur expo).



It's important to note that your stopwatch doesn't start until you cross the start line.

How do I get to the start of the Baloise Namur Half Marathon?

OPTION 1: I chose the train shuttle

Two train shuttles will take you to the start of the Half Marathon. Shuttle buses are also organised to take you to the start of the Half Marathon. The train shuttle leaves from **Namur station** (<u>Place de la Station 1, 5000 Namur</u>). It takes about 10 minutes on foot to get to the station from Namur Expo. There are two train departure times: **Tortue** and **Lièvre**. It is possible that the trains are full, we will have a fleet of private buses. You will then receive information by **email**.



There is a detachable tab on your race number. It must be attached to your bag before being placed in the vehicle that will take your bag to the finish. The maximum bag size is 20 litres. Only bags are accepted at the locker. If you plan to take a piece of clothing to keep warm, it will be possible to deposit it in a container of the ASBL TERRE. The clothes will then be recycled. You collect your bag in the runners' area after the finish. It will be stored in the file corresponding to your race number.

─ Supplies



7. ARRIVAL

- Once you have crossed the finish line, you will receive a bottle of POWERADE and you will be invited to enter the runners' area to receive your medal (see point 9), to access the fin refreshment area and to the bag check.
- It is forbidden to remain in the space just after the finish line, you must **absolutely** move forward to collect your Powerade and your medal.
- Medal engraving takes place outside the runners' area, just outside the exit.
- The **physio** area is outside the runners' area, on the right.
- Complimentary drinks will be distributed on presentation of your race number at the organisers' bar (see map below).
- An advanced medical post (AMP) is organised on arrival. Emergency number: 112
- It is possible to engrave your medal on site without reservation (payment on site) in the exhibition village.

8. ADDITIONAL INFORMATIONS

→ Where and when can I collect my race bib?

If you were invited to collect your number from Trakks and did not do so before 3 April 2025, your number will be at Namur Expo. It will be at the race number stand from 1.30pm to 8pm on Saturday 5 April and from 5.46am on Sunday 6 April.

Race numbers can be collected for **ALL** on 5 April from 2pm until 8pm and on Sunday 6 April from 5.45am at Namur Expo in the race number area. Race numbers for the KickCancer 10K can be collected until 12 noon at their own stand (see map).

→ When and where can I collect my T-shirt?

On 5 April from 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. and on Sunday 6 April from 5.45 a.m., you can collect your race number at the race number office.

If you already have your race number, the t-shirt will be available on April 5 and 6, 2024 before (at the number pick-up area) and after the race (at the organization stand in the Village expo).

For ALL others, you must collect your race number in the race number area.

→ I want to change SAS.

Applications can be made at the Info-Point (see map below) during Exhibition Village opening hours on Saturday 5 April and until 8am on Sunday 6 April.

→ I want to take the shuttle.

Applications can be made at the NAVETTE point (see map below) during the opening hours of the exhibition village on Saturday 5 April and until 8am on Sunday 6 April.

- Time barrier: all riders must cross the line by 3 p.m. at the latest
- **Engraving of the medal:** at the exit of the runners' area

Are there any toilets?

Yes, at the starting points and feed stations.

─ Results

The results will be posted on our website. (on 8 April 2025). The ranking will be based on real time.

Pictures

You will receive an email allowing you to view your photos on the course. These photos are taken by <u>Sportograf</u>.

Personal attendant/ravito :

Bicycles, scooters and other vehicles are strictly forbidden on the course under penalty of exclusion.

It is forbidden to cross the line with a third party (the officials will disqualifier).

You can refuel outside the designated areas, while respecting the environment and the people around you.

It is forbidden to dispose of rubbish outside the feed zones, under penalty of exclusion.

Race transfer

For any race transfer, it is **compulsory** to present yourself on Saturday at Namur Expo to make the race change. **NO TRANSFERS ON SUNDAY**.

Race bib

Bib transfers will only take place on **Saturday 5 April 2025**. If an option is not printed on your race number, you did not choose it at registration.

The race bib is made up of a tab that can be removed and attached to the bag that you leave at the cloakroom on the start line.



PLEASE NOTE: you cannot return to the runners' area once

you have left it.



When you cross the finish line, you will be invited to go to the runners' area to collect your medal, refuel and get your bag.

10. Spectators

There's plenty of entertainment along the marathon route (brass band, drums, DJ, bagpipes, etc.).

11. Mobility info

We strongly advise you to:

- use the public transport provided
- encourage car-sharing
- use the WAZE application to find the departure points and Namur Expo
- Don't use the Meuse valley to get to the start of the half-marathon by car.
- All of these informations can be find on our website (mobility)

Plane: the nearest airports are Brussels Airport and Charleroi Airport. From these airports, there are rail and road links to Namur.

By train: Namur is served by its main railway station. International connections via TGV/Eurostar are at Brussels-Midi, with a direct connection to Namur.

By car: Namur is accessible by motorway depending on where you are coming from.

- From Charleroi, Mons, Tournai: E42, exit 12 Namur-Ouest
- From Bruxelles: E411, exit 14 Namur-Centre
- From Luxembourg and the south of the province of Namur: E411, exit 15 Loyers

- The BUS boards opposite Namur Expo, on the TEC platform.

The choice of shuttle is firm and final. We do not accept any changes to the departure time. You will be checked before boarding the bus.

By car (strongly discouraged):

- Drop-off along the N92 at rue de la Justice or rue des Griottes.
- Parking: parking spots are limited, so please respect police restrictions.

Semi-Marathon

To get to Profondeville and the start of the Half-Marathon: HERE

The start of the half-marathon is in Lustin (Profondeville). We strongly advise you to take the shuttle train to get to the start.

By train:

- By train from all stations in Wallonia: trains will run according to the normal timetable apart from the organisation's shuttle buses, timetable on the <u>SNCB</u> webside.
- Two special 'half-marathon' train shuttles will run from Namur station to Lustin station.
 It will be possible to add the shuttle option (€4) at Namur Expo on Saturday 5 April 2025.

The start of the KickCancer 10k takes place at La Plante. We strongly advise you to take the BUS TEC shuttle bus to get to the start.

By bus:

The organisers will provide you with BUS TEC shuttles. Please use this mode of transport. It will be possible to add the shuttle option (€4) at Namur Expo on Saturday 5 April 2025.

- The BUS boards opposite Namur Expo on the TEC platform.
- Please respect your choice of shuttle.

BUS SHUTTLE TIMETABLE:

- BUS TEC 10k 6, 7, 8, 9: departs at 12.20 p.m.

The choice of shuttle is firm and final. We do not accept any changes to the departure time. You will be checked before boarding the bus.

- Free on-street parking in Jambes on Sundays

Return shuttles

We are providing free return TEC BUS shuttles for participants in the 10k and 21k who park their cars at the starting point. The return shuttle leaves from the TEC stop in front of Namur-Expo.

From Salzinnes, TEC stop 'Namur EXPO':
